Recycling Household Batteries

The City of Kearney would like to remind residents that household batteries can be recycled. To add convenience to recycling batteries, drop-off sites have been established at the following locations:

- Kearney Area Recycling Center, 3007 East 39th Street
- Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Site, located southeast of the City Public Works Building, 1919 15th Avenue
- Ace Hardware, 307 West 56th Street
- Builders, 4600 2nd Avenue
- True Value, 1314 East 25th Street
- Orscheln Farm and Home, 910 3rd Avenue
- Tractor Supply Company, 514 3rd Avenue

Recycling batteries helps to keep harmful metals such as nickel, mercury, lead, and cadmium out of our environment. The following is a list of batteries that can be left at the designated drop-off locations:

- AAA
- AA
- C
- D
- 9-Volt
- Button Cell Batteries
- Rechargeable Batteries (laptop and cell phone)

Please continue to take any lead-acid or car batteries to our drop-off sites at 3007 East 39th Street and at 1919 15th Avenue. These batteries can also be taken to Anderson Wrecking, located at 1912 Avenue M, or to Alter Metal Recycling at 4211 East 43 Street Place to be recycled.
