4th Street Utility Work

The City of Kearney Utilities Department and Midlands Contracting Inc. announce that work is continuing on the South Sewer Project and the next phase of the project will be on 4th Street west of Central Avenue.

Beginning Monday, March 2, 2015 4th Street will be closed from Central Avenue westward 400 feet to the east side of the Dairy Queen's west driveway located at 112 East 4th Street. All services to businesses along 4th Street will remain open and access to 2nd Avenue East will not be affected at this time.

Immediately following the road closure, crews will remove the paving west of Central Avenue approximately 400 feet. After the pavement removal is completed the installation of two groundwater dewatering wells will begin. Once the wells are in place, crews will continue with the installation of the sanitary sewer main and encasement pipe.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area, to watch for construction workers and machinery, and to make plans to use an alternate route to avoid the closed portion of 4th Street.
