Inlet Marking Event

The City of Kearney would like to announce that students from the University of Nebraska at Kearney will be conducting a storm inlet marking event in the vicinity south of Centennial Park and the surrounding residential neighborhoods on Tuesday, April 14, 2015, weather permitting.

This event will cover the areas between 2nd Avenue to Kea West Avenue and from Talmadge Street to 11th Street. The event will begin around 6:00 p.m. During the event participants will be marking inlets with the “NO DUMPING, DRAINS TO RIVER” message on inlet boxes along the roadways in these areas. In addition to marking the inlets they will be distributing informational fliers to the neighborhood homes about water quality and environmental protection.

The City of Kearney asks that motorists traveling in these areas use extreme caution and watch for participants of the event.
