Comprehensive Plan Designs on Display

On Thursday, April 16 the City of Kearney and JEO Consulting Group will host a Town Hall meeting at the Kearney Public Library to display Urban Design features being developed as part of the comprehensive planning process. Tuesday, April 14 thru Thursday, April 16 consultants will work on example proposals for projects that could address issues expressed in the recent Community Summit, focus group meetings, and Town Halls and inspire the community in the implementation of goals being developed in the Comp Plan. The results will be pinned-up from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers on the 2nd floor of City Hall; the public is invited to view and comment.

The Comprehensive Plan is a requirement under State law to assess existing development and project future needs for transportation infrastructure, recreation and parks facilities, and private growth in housing, commercial, and industrial areas. Citizen input is essential to ensure the Plan represents the needs and desires of the community. This Comprehensive Plan also makes extensive use of online engagement for citizens who are unable to attend in-person meetings. The City of Kearney hopes to have the Comprehensive Plan completed and presented to City Council for adoption in December 2015.
