North Railroad Street Between Avenues D and E

The City of Kearney Utilities Department announces that the eastbound lane of North Railroad Street between Avenues D and E will be closed and the street will be reduced to one lane of traffic starting on Monday, October 26. Flaggers will be present during the work and motorists should use caution during the time when flaggers are not present. The lane will be closed in order to fix a water leak underneath the paving. All lanes should be reopened to traffic on Friday, October 30, weather permitting.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution in the area and to watch for construction workers and machinery. If possible, motorists are encouraged to use another route to reach their destination.
