Antelope Avenue between Hwy 30 and Coal Chute Road

The City of Kearney Utilities Department and Public Works Department announce that Antelope Avenue between Highway 30 and Coal Chute Road will be narrowed to one lane traffic, starting on Tuesday, December 8. The lane will be closed in order to replace a sanitary sewer manhole ring and cover in the paving. Traffic will be maintained around this closure. Pedestrians should watch for oncoming traffic. All lanes should be reopened to traffic on Friday, December 11, weather permitting.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution in the area and to watch for construction workers and machinery. If possible motorists are encouraged to use another route to reach their destination
