Downtown Snow Emergency and Parking Ban in Effect for Downtown Snow Removal

The City of Kearney Street Division announces that a Snow Emergency has been declared for the Downtown area of the City of Kearney. Parking is prohibited between the hours of **1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Friday, February 5, 2016** for the following streets for the purpose of removing snow. **VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED.**

Businesses in the Downtown area should make plans to have their walks scooped by 1:00 a.m. so that the snow can be hauled in connection with the snow removal operations. It is possible the snow removal may not be completed in one night. If that is the case, City crews will continue work the following evening from 1:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
