### **Antelope Avenue Between 56th Street and 39th Street Road Closure**

The City of Kearney Utilities Department and Midlands Contracting Inc. announce that utility work on Antelope Avenue will require Antelope Avenue to be closed between 56th Street and 39th Street beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 1, 2016. Construction crews will be installing a sanitary sewer main and will be connecting to the existing sanitary sewer main located in the southbound lane in Antelope Avenue. All lanes should be reopened to traffic by 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 6, 2016, weather permitting.

The City would also like to remind motorists that 56th Street east of Antelope Avenue still remains closed due the construction activities associated with the Cherry Avenue Bypass Project.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area, to watch for construction workers and machinery, and to make plans to use an alternate route to get to their destination.
