UPRR Cherry Avenue Crossing and Cherry Avenue North of Highway 30 Permanent Closures

As part of the new Kearney East Bypass Phase II construction project, the existing at-grade Union Pacific Rail Road crossing at Cherry Avenue will be permanently closed on October 31, 2016. Motorists will need to use alternate locations to cross the UPRR tracks until the new bypass is opened, which is now scheduled for mid to late November.

On Tuesday, November 1, 2016, Cherry Avenue on the north side of Highway 30 will close permanently. Access to industries and other locations east of the project will be via the new Link Road. Signs and barricades will be erected to guide motorists thru the work areas until the remaining closed roadways are opened to traffic.
