Kearney High School and Berean Church Vandalism

At approximately 2:16 a.m. on Friday, November 11, 2016, Police Officers responded to an alarm at the Berean Church at 1004 30th Avenue, Kearney, NE. It was discovered both exterior and interior windows had been shattered along with damage to interior and exterior doors and walls, as well other items both inside and out. A short time later, Officers discovered approximately twenty-one exterior and interior windows and eleven exterior and interior doors shattered and damaged at the new Kearney High School.

A 21 year-old Kearney man, Mason Glause, was located nearby and arrested for Burglary, Criminal Mischief, 2nd Degree Trespassing and Theft. The estimated damage is not known at the time of the Press Release.

The Kearney Police Department and the Buffalo County Sheriff's Office are both involved in the ongoing investigations.
