MAJOR PROJECTS

- 31st Street - Avenue A to Avenue D (reworking concrete)
- 31st Street Traffic Signal at Avenue A
- Avenue E - 25th Street to 27th Street (replace asphalt with concrete)
- Tech One Boulevard (street within the new tech park)
- Country Club Lane Bridge (Reconstruct bridge deck, guard rails, sidewalk, approach slabs and fencing)
- 56th Street - 6th Avenue to 19th Avenue (widen roadway to 4 lane)
- Traffic Signal at 17th Avenue & 56th Street (replacing temporary flashing stop signs)
- 17th Avenue - 50th to 56th Street (widen to 4 lane)
- Talmadge Street West of 2nd Avenue (reconstruct street from 2nd to 4th Avenue)
- Downtown Streetlights, Beautification, Irrigation
- Airport Runway Rehab
- Bike Trail - Phase 2 Archway East
- East Brooke Park - shelter, playground, splashpad, trail
- Patriot Park - ballfields, batting facility

SALES TAX

City of Kearney relies primarily on Sales Tax Dollars, not property tax. Sales Tax pays for:

parks, trails, library, programs
- Safety
police, fire
- Infrastructure
streets, maintenance




