Sealed bids for the construction of 2017 Part 3 Improvements, 11th Street – 7th Avenue to 14th Avenue, Kearney, Nebraska, will be received by the City of Kearney, Nebraska, at the office of the City Clerk, 18 East 22nd Street, Kearney, Nebraska 68847 until 2 p.m. local time on February 1, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers.

The project consists of reconstructing approximately 13,000 square yards of PCC paving on 11th Street, from 7th Avenue to 14th Avenue, and all other associated work as indicated on the drawings and within the specifications.

Bids shall be on a per Unit Basis.
