### **December Priority Traffic Enforcement Area - Results**

During the month of December, Officers completed 63 hours of increased enforcement efforts in the Priority Traffic Enforcement Areas of:

- 2nd Avenue (39th – 56th Street)
- N Avenue (27th – 56th Street)
- Talmadge Street and 2nd Avenue

Officers had a total of 235 traffic contacts for a variety of violations to include Traffic Signal Violation, Improper Turns, and Failure to Yield. All violations which are a common contributing factor in vehicle crashes.

The ultimate goal of these enforcement areas is to reduce the number of vehicle collisions at high traffic volume intersections and roadways throughout the city. We encourage motorists to drive safely, obey speed limits, traffic control devices, avoid distraction, and wear your seatbelts.
