### **Multi-Agency Effort Leads To Felony Narcotics Arrests**

On Wednesday, August 31, 2022 at approximately 5:45am, acting on information obtained by a Kearney Uniformed Police Officer during a traffic stop, officers and investigators with Kearney Police Department and the Tri-Cities Drug Enforcement Team (TRIDENT) served a search warrant in the 1400 block of 2nd Avenue in Kearney attempting to locate two fugitives who had felony warrants for their arrest.

Officers located the two fugitives, identified as 27-year-old Jarred Shah of North Platte and 19-year-old Abigail Allmon of Kearney.

Shah was arrested on a parole violation from Lincoln County. Allmon was arrested on a bench warrant out of Buffalo County District Court.

As a result of the arrests and search warrants, officers located approximately 4 ounces of Methamphetamine, Fentanyl, various prescription pills, drug paraphernalia, and cash indicative of narcotics sales and distribution. Both Shah and Allmon were arrested and booked into the Buffalo County Jail on multiple narcotics related offenses including 11 felonies and 3 misdemeanors.

The Tri-Cities Drug Enforcement Team (TRIDENT) is an FBI task force with members from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Kearney Police Department, Nebraska State Patrol, Buffalo County Sheriff's Office, Hastings Police Department, Grand Island Police Department, and the Hall County Sheriff's Office.
