REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Kearney Police Department Service Weapon Replacement

The City of Kearney through the Kearney Police Department is requesting proposals from qualified vendors to provide a standard duty size handgun to be utilized for uniformed and non-uniformed officers. It is anticipated that seventy (70) service weapons will be purchased and requires an option for officers to buy-back their handguns.

The City of Kearney is an equal opportunity employer and requires all contractors and vendors to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations.

Scope of Services & Minimum Specifications

Proposal must include the cost per weapon including all the listed accessories and shipping to the Kearney Police Department, or FFL dealer if required by law. It is anticipated that seventy (70) primary duty handguns to replace inventory.

- Caliber: 9x19mm
- Capacity: Minimum 17 (standard) +1
- Action: Striker
- Barrel Length: 102mm / 4.02 inch (marksman grade)
- Sites: Night Sites
- Safety: Internal Safety
- Trigger Pull: 26N
- Length: 189mm / 7.44 inch
- Height 1.39mm / 5.47 w./ mag.
- Weight w/empty mag.: 695g / 24.52 oz.
- Handgrips: Adjustable sizes with Modular Backstrap System (MBS)
- Magazine Release: Reversible or Ambidextrous
- Accessory Rail
- Slide Accessory with front & rear serrations (FS & RS)
- Compliant with Modular Optic System (MOS)
- Color/Finish: hard-surface finish nDLC in non-reflective black
- Magazines: 3 per handgun

Equipment Delivery Requirements

- The vendor is responsible for delivery to the Kearney Police Department or Federal Firearms Licensee, as applicable.

Trade-in and Officer Buyback Provision

- The City of Kearney requires a sixty-day (60-day) window from receipt of the new service weapons to complete the exchange of trade-in or Officer Buyback service weapons. This will ensure that officers can certify with their new service weapons before turning in their current firearm.

Submission Requirements

The proposed design(s) shall be compatible with the site. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to confirm available space and compatibility for each design.

Submittals should be easy to follow and labeled 1-5, following the minimum requirements listed below, with additional information at the end as applicable.

Each proposal shall include at minimum: one (1) original and five (5) copies for necessary distribution. Submittals should be labeled 1-5, following the minimum submittal requirements. The following are the minimum submittal requirements:

1. Signed Cover Page
2. Proposal Form
3. Company background (brief information on company's experience and qualifications, number of years in business, support services)
4. Delivery timeline of firearms
5. A cost proposal, including the cost per handgun and trade-in values per handgun for consideration
6. Copy of manufactures warranty

The City of Kearney will accept only those sealed proposals, either hand delivered or received via U.S. Mail or other commercial carrier received at the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 18 East 22nd Street, Kearney, Nebraska. Items transmitted by facsimile or electronically will not be accepted. Late receipt of submittals will not be considered regardless of postmark. All proposals will be validated. Evaluation

Each proposal received, within the project budget, will be evaluated on the following criteria to determine an overall score:

Project Schedule: Maximum Score: 10 points

- Please provide a detailed timeline of all activities associated with the project.

Vendor Experience and Qualifications: Maximum Score: 30 points

- Business address
- Years in business
- Description of Vendor's service after the sale
- Three references on similar sized municipal purchases

Technical: Maximum Score: 40 Points

- Compliance with RFP
- Research and understanding of purchase requirements
- Product specifications/warranty

Cost: Maximum Score: 20 Points

Total: Maximum Score: 100 Points

Selection Process

The Review Committee will consist of administrative staff and firearm instructors from the Kearney Police Department in order to solicit input from a variety of viewpoints.

The Review Committee anticipates making a recommendation to the City Council on February 9, 2021, or sooner. The City Council will select the most responsible Vendor for the project. This Request for Proposals does not commit the City of Kearney to award a contract, to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of a proposal for this request, or to procure or contract for services. The City of Kearney reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals received as a result of this request, to negotiate with any qualified firm or to modify or cancel in part or in its entirety the Request for Proposals, if it is in the best interest of the City of Kearney to do so.

If an award is made to the Request for Proposals, a purchase order will be issued to the selected vendor for execution.
