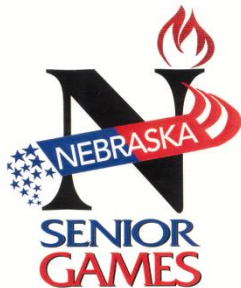
**Jr. Recreational Tennis Tournament**
