

Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy



The NDEE requires a construction stormwater general permit, or CSW general permit, that provides coverage from construction and support activity that causes land *disturbance of equal to or greater than one acre and less than one acre if the construction activity is part of a common plan of development or sale.

(*disturbance=construction footprint+staging area+any area disturbed by construction activity.)

Each NER210000 Permit requires the following documents be submitted for the Notice of Intent (NOI):

- A Nebraska Game and Parks 'CERT' document.
- A Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) unique to the project site. (With Erosion and Sediment Control Plan)
- A map identifying project location.

The NDEE NOI Review process can take between 2-3 days. The NDEE will alert you if changes need to be made. The 'Certifying Official' and SWPPP Designer will receive an NOI Approval Letter upon successful completion.

Nebraska Game and Parks Commission



The NGPC requires NER210000 applicants to fill out a 'Conservation and Environmental Review Tool' (CERT Document).

The CERT Document application process is located at the following website:

cert.outdoornebraska.gov

- Select 'Map' tab, then zoom in on project.
- Select 'Switch Basemap' to see an aerial view.
- Select 'Create Project' and click once to begin and twice to end the polygon.
- Select 'Accept' and begin filling out 'Project Info' and 'Project Description'.

The more information you provide, the quicker the response by the NGPC will be. The NGPC will use this information to determine if construction activity on this site will have 'No effect' on the environment and be signed/dated and be completed, **OR** if the site activity 'May effect' the environment and require further consultation. Whether or not a consultation is needed will determine the length of the CERT process.

Required Construction Inspections

During the entire construction process the NER210000 Permit Holder is responsible to ensure that mud, dirt, rocks, and other debris are not allowed to enter onto streets and sidewalks, nor be tracked onto streets by construction vehicles. Inspections are to be done on a regular frequency as de-scribed in the permit. These inspections are to be performed by the permit holder.

Any mud or other debris on the street must be removed immediately or at least by the end of that work day. Violations not corrected may result in suspension of building inspections until the issues are resolved.

CITY OF KEARNEY CODE

9-1607 Prohibitions

- a. ...it is unlawful for any person to discharge non-stormwater into the City MS4.
- b. ...it is unlawful for any person or representative to damage or remove any approved stormwater pollution control measure without the owner's knowledge or consent.
- c. Stormwater discharges from construction activities shall not cause or threaten to cause pollution, contamination or degradation of waters of the state.


