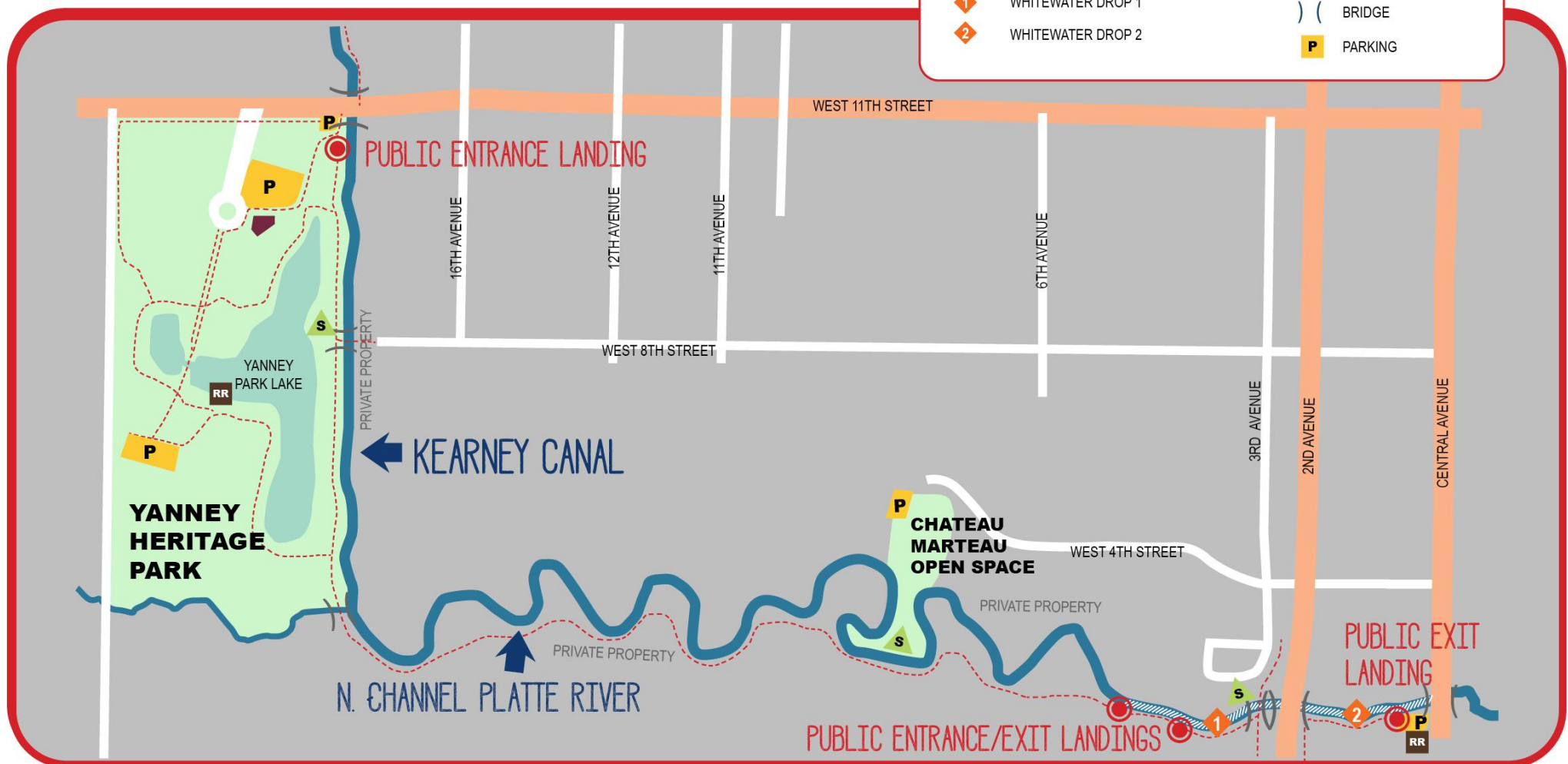

Changing your mode of travel to kayak or canoe, the Kearney Water Trail is a one-of-kind amenity in central Nebraska that attracts thousands of users. The typical season length is April through October. Fed by the Kearney Canal, the water trail joins the North Channel of the Platte River, otherwise known as Turkey Creek. An entrance landing and trailhead parking is available at Yanney Park. The exit landing is located on the west side of Central Avenue. The water trail offers a unique recreational opportunity.
